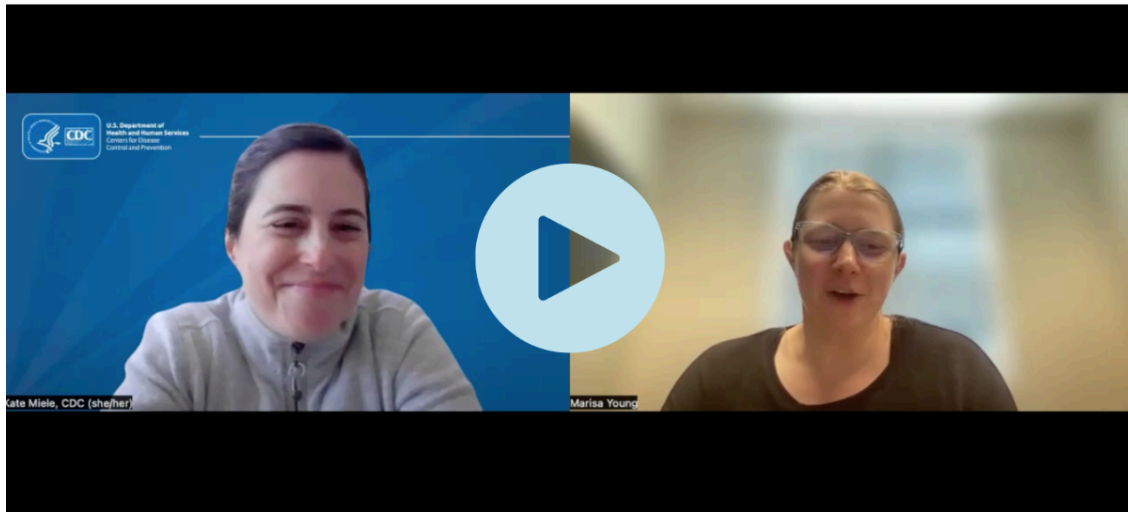

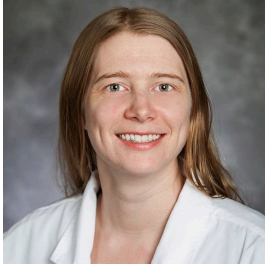

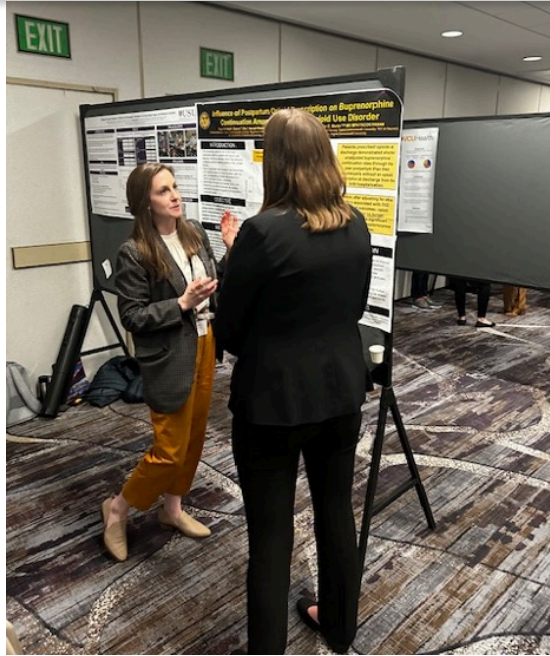
Share Your Good News
